I wanted to let you know about two exciting outings that Class 1 have got planned for the weeks ahead.



WEDNESDAY 28TH JUNE – A DAY AT THE BEACH

We will travel in our school minibuses to the 'Bluff' beach. The children will need to wear clothes suitable for the beach and bring a packed lunch and plenty of drinks for the day. It is very important that they have sun cream applied in the morning and wear a sun hat. We will be asking a Lifeguard to stay with us, so the children may just go paddling (only up to their knees)! The children will learn about staying healthy and safe in the sun, beach safety and why exercise is so important for our bodies.

TUESDAY 4TH JULY – AN AMAZINGLY FANTASTIC VISIT TO FEADON FARM!!!

We have visited Feadon Farm in the past with a previous class and it really was a fantastic experience and one of the best trips we have organised. The children are able to see close up the foxes, ferrets, snakes, bats, spiders, hedgehogs, etc, etc and watch the Harris Hawk flying. One of the highlights of our day out will be the opportunity for the children to actually help fly the Barn & Eagle owls (don't worry – it's all very safe).



We shall travel to Portreath in our school minibuses. The children may wear their own play clothes, with sensible footwear and a waterproof coat/sun hat and sun cream. (We will be outside for most of the day). They will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day.

If your child requires a packed lunch from our school canteen for either of these visits, this can be arranged. Please let the office know by Monday 26th June if one is required.

The total cost for these two outings will be contribution of £10. This includes a contribution towards the minibus expenses and our entry and all activities at Feadon Farm. Please would you sign and return the slip below, confirming your child is able to participate.
