There will be a short time for play in Ferdi's Funland in the afternoon.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them and plenty of drinks for the day. If you would prefer, we can order a packed lunch from our school canteen, please let us know on the slip below if one is required.

The overall cost of this trip works out at £13 per pupil (£6.50 entrance fee for Flambards & £6.50 towards the coach travel). However, Flambards have kindly agreed that if your child has a season ticket pass, they may use this on our school trip, meaning you would just need to pay the contribution for the coach travel of £6.50. If this applies to your child, please indicate this below and send the pass into school with the permission slip.

Past experience has shown us that the children really benefit from these outings, so I hope you will support us on this occasion.
