VISIT TO GWEEK SEAL SANCTUARY – WEDNESDAY 6TH JUNE

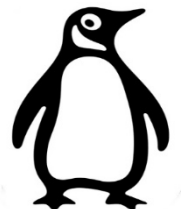
This term, the children in Class 2 are studying the topic "Under the Sea". As part of our learning, we are planning a visit to the Seal Sanctuary at Gweek, on Wednesday 6th June. We will be able to learn about the seals and penguins during the animal talks and watch them being fed. We will explore the rock pools and learn about the poorly seals that are being treated at the hospital.



We shall travel to Gweek in our school minibuses. **The children may wear trousers or tracksuit bottoms with a t-shirt but they must wear their Penpol school jumper or cardigan. There will be a lot of walking involved, so the children will need to wear comfortable shoes such as trainers.** As we will be spending most of the day outside, please make sure your child brings a sun hat, some sun cream and a waterproof coat. They will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day. If you would prefer, we can order a packed lunch from the school canteen – please indicate on the slip below if one is required.

We shall leave Penpol at about 9.15am and be back for the usual end of school time.

The contribution for this trip will be £6, which includes entry to the Seal Sanctuary and travelling expenses. Please would you sign and return the slip below giving permission for your child to attend. Thank you for your co-operation.
