

#### Local Authority Monitoring

On Tuesday, we were visited by Barbara Dyer and Sue Smith for a Local Authority Monitoring Visit. As a community school, this forms an important part of our support and development package from the county. There were many very positive findings from the visit. For example:

- 'Children are confident, articulate and able to share respectfully with quality relationships evident throughout, in orderly classrooms. Behaviour is high quality across the school with learning engagement increasingly evident'.
- 'Penpol School is a happy, vibrant learning community, well led by the new headteacher with committed staff working harmoniously to offer a 'truly 21st century learning experience', as stated on their easy to navigate, lively and interesting website. The school is now securely placed to sustain the journey of school improvement'.

Development points identified were consistent with our current School Improvement Plan, now available on our website, providing confirmation that we are very much on the right journey for our children. More details about the monitoring visit findings will be discussed at our *School Priorities* parent/carer workshop on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> July. Many thanks to our staff team and children for being so warm and welcoming towards our visitors.

#### AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM HAYLE LIBRARY

Dear Parents

I don't know if you are aware that there a lot of children that suffer during the school summer holidays from the absence of free school meals and breakfast clubs that are run during term time. In Cornwall in 2015 one foodbank alone provided 2,500 meals to children during the school holidays. An APPG (All Party Parliamentary Group) report into hunger in the school holidays found about 3 million children nationally were at risk of going without meals during the summer holidays. As I'm sure you'll agree these are really high figures that are quite upsetting to contemplate.

We as a library have decided to try and help the children in our community by having a 'Fill the Gap' collection during the month of June to help the foodbank feed our local children during the summer holidays. We would be very grateful if parents would help contribute any 'Breakfast or lunch perishable foods' to our collection at any point during June, you can drop it off at the library Mondays Wednesdays and Fridays 9.30-5pm and Saturday mornings 10.00-1.00pm, every small donation of food helps however small.
