The percentage of children achieving the expected standard in year 6 compared with national averages is broadly in line in RWM and GPS. Writing, maths and science are significantly above the national average whilst reading is below.

Percentage of pupils achieving the greater depth standard:

The percentage of children achieving the greater depth standard in year 6 at national averages is below in reading and maths but above in writing.

The average scaled score is broadly in line with national averages in all areas.

Progress measure: (KS1 to KS2)

Awaiting national confidence intervals for comparison but these are historically close to Cornwall averages. Reading is below expected progress measures but writing is significantly above and maths is above Cornwall averages.
