CHRISTMAS COLLECTION FOR HAYLE FOODBANK

In previous years, parents have kindly donated an item for Christmas for the Hayle Foodbank.

This year, we would like to help the local foodbank once again and so have decided to support their 'Reverse Advent Calendar' campaign. We are sure most children know about the usual advent calendars, whereby you open a window each day and may sometimes find some chocolate! The idea of this campaign is to put a food item back for every day.

Classes will try to make their own hamper with 25 items inside – this would mean that if every child in all of our classes were able to bring just one item, we would be able to donate 14 hampers to the Hayle Foodbank.



Items could include basic ingredients like a bag of pasta, tins of soup or a packet of breakfast cereal. Or if you were able to donate an item a little more luxurious for Christmas, this might include a Christmas pudding, a box of chocolates or some mince pies. As the hampers will need to be stored for a little while, please do not include perishable items like fruit, vegetables or meat.
