

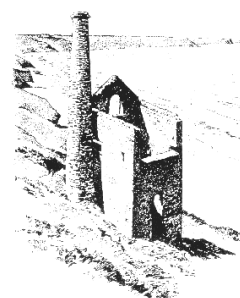

CLASS 7 SCHOOL TRIP – TUESDAY 4TH DECEMBER - GEEVOR TIN MINE AT PENDEEN

As part of their Science work this term, Class 7 have been looking at the topic of 'Rocks & Soils'. We plan to visit Geevor Tin Mine at Pendeen, on Tuesday 4th December as this will put into real life some of the work the children have been studying in class. We shall be able to pan for gold, drill into different rocks and take a guided tour, actually down into the mine. Hard hats will be provided! The details of our trip are as follows:

If your child would like to replicate a miner's lunch from the past, they may like to bring a pasty wrapped in tin foil for their lunch!!! We will leave this up to you and your child to decide.

The cost of our trip will be £7 – this will cover our minibus expenses, admission to the mine and all of our planned activities for the day. The education officer from Geevor will also visit Penpol to lead a workshop with the children in order that they may get the most out of their visit.
