Dear Parents/Carers,

Penpol School has grown significantly in recent years, with our pupil community currently numbering 395 amazing individuals. In light of this and with the departure of Sarah Connors from her role as Assistant Headteacher this April, the governing body and I have carefully reviewed the current leadership structure to ensure that we have the capacity needed to continue to deliver the best provision possible for our pupils.

I am pleased to announce that we have appointed Mr Jonathan Peck as our Acting Deputy Headteacher for the summer term. Jonathan is a highly skilled and experienced leader, formally a headteacher himself. He is currently our Assessment Lead and a class teacher in Year 6. I know that Jonathan will be a huge asset to this new role.

Mr Peck will remain in class for much of the week, particularly up until the Key Stage 2 SATs in May, and will still accompany the children on their very exciting trip to London. Beyond SATs, it is likely that his time out of class will need to increase. However, we are committed to ensuring that the children in Class 14 receive the most consistent provision possible as they prepare for the next phase of their school careers, with both Mr Peck and Wendy Turner playing a significant role in this.

We will soon be recruiting a permanent Deputy Headteacher for next Autumn and will update you in due course.
