CLASSES 3 & 4 VISIT TO ST IVES ON MONDAY 1ST APRIL

Classes 3 & 4 have an exciting day out to St Ives planned for Monday 1st April, to link in with our science and art work this term on materials and buildings.

Our busy itinerary will include a visit to the Tate Gallery where we will be having a 'Sketch Book' tour of the Anna Boghiguian exhibition. We will also visit the Barbara Hepworth Museum and Sculpture Gardens which will give us an insight into the work of one of Britain's most important twentieth century artists. Sculptures in bronze, stone and wood are on display in the museum and garden, along with paintings and drawings. We then plan to spend some time on the beach, designing and building our very own sand sculptures.



We will travel to St Ives by coach, leaving school at 9.15am and plan to be back by the normal end of school time. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water for the day. If you would prefer, we can prepare a school packed lunch. Please let us know by Thursday 28th March if one is required. Please can the children wear their usual Penpol uniform on the top with some comfortable trousers (jeans, leggings, etc.) and either wellies or old trainers as we will be getting sandy at the beach.

The voluntary contribution for this trip will be £6.50. This will cover the coach expenses and all of our planned activities for the day. We hope you will be able to support this outing as it will help to re-enforce the learning that we do in class.
