GREENPOWER CAR RACING – CLASS 11 SCHOOL TRIP ON WEDNESDAY 3RD JULY

We are very excited to let you know about a school trip we have planned for next Wednesday 3rd July. We will be visiting the Predannick Airfield near Mullion where we will be watching the Green Goblin Car Racing event. It will be our aim to purchase our own school kit car to build and then race in this event next year.



Greenpower Education Trust is a UK based charity which gets young people enthusiastic about science and engineering by challenging them to design, build and race an electric car. They supply age-appropriate Kit Cars which can be built in school, college or elsewhere and raced at motorsport venues at Greenpower organised events. The Greenpower challenge uses the excitement of motorsport to inspire young people to excel in Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM).

We will leave school soon after registration and travel over to Mullion in our school minibuses. Please could children wear their school uniform with sensible walking shoes and a coat, or sun hat and sun cream depending on the weather conditions. They will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of drinking water for the day. We will be back at school for the usual end of school time.

There will be no monetary contribution required for this visit as we are aware parents had already paid for a visit earlier in the year to the Met Office, which sadly did not take place.
