Dear Parents/Carers

Y3 & 4 Activity Day and Sleepover - Friday 5th July - Saturday 6th July 2019

The activity day and sleepover are nearly upon us and it is time to finalise a few details. Staff attending the camp will be Mrs Peck, Mrs Keeler, Miss Holcroft, Mrs Riches, Mrs Smart and Mr Jones. Final payments for the Activity Day and sleepover will need to be in by Friday 28th June. The total price is £16. If you have any concerns regarding payments and deadlines please contact the office. The activity day will be during the school day and all children will be involved regardless of whether they are attending the sleepover. The cost for taking part in the Activity Day only is £8.

On the Friday, the children will come to school as normal. They will need to wear home clothes suitable for the planned activities. **Also, they will need a packed lunch as we are planning a large picnic**. There will be four activities during the day and the children will get equal time on each. They are; rock climbing, archery, shelter building and orienteering. At 3:15pm the children will leave school as normal.

If they are attending the sleepover, the children will come back to school for 5pm. They will need to set up their beds in the appropriate places (you may help them with this if you wish). Year 3 will be in the hall and Year 4 in the Year 5 classrooms (Classes 11 & 12). Please note that we will be providing dinner on the Friday evening, snacks and breakfast the following morning. For the Friday night, the children will need to choose from the following options; fish and chips, sausage and chips or cheesy chips. Please indicate on the slip below what your child would like. The children may bring some extra snacks if they wish but please make sure your child has a water bottle for refilling. The children will need collecting the following morning at 9am.

On the reverse of this letter is a kit list that will cover everything needed. Please ensure that your child brings a hat and sun cream as we will be spending a lot of time outside or waterproof clothing if the weather is wet. Can I also remind you that the children are not allowed to bring mobile phones, I-pads, tablets or any other valuable items. Label everything where possible please!

If you require any more forms or kit lists, please ask in the office. Please book to see Mrs Riches or myself if you require any further information or would like to discuss anything. We are all looking forward to what promises to be a very exciting and enjoyable time.
