Dear Parents

Class 6 are planning to spend a day at the beach on Monday 15th July. We shall visit the Gwithian/Godrevy area and will travel there in our school minibuses. The children will be accompanied by 4 adults. This day out will link into our History and Geography studies this term and will be a lovely end of term treat for the children. We will have a talk from the lifeguards about beach safety and will be making sand sculptures.



The children will need to come to school wearing home clothes suitable for the beach, to include a t-shirt, shorts, sensible walking shoes, (no flip-flops), and bring with them a towel and a swimsuit and a coat. They may also bring beach shoes if they wish. The children will be able to go into the water as there will be lifeguard supervision.

Please may the children bring a packed lunch and plenty of water to drink for

the day. If you would prefer, we can provide a packed lunch from our school canteen. <u>If your child</u> wishes, they may bring £2.50 in cash on the day to buy an ice cream.

The cost of this outing will be £1 per child to cover the minibus expenses. This visit is now set up on our ParentPay system. Please log on to make your £1 contribution, give permission for your child to participate, let us know of any medical conditions and to order a packed lunch if one is required.
