## CLASS 1 DAY OUT TO FEADON FARM, PORTREATH – WEDNESDAY 17<sup>TH</sup> JULY

Class 1 are planning to spend an exciting day at Feadon Farm near Portreath on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July. This will link in with our studies this term on growth and animals and we will have an Educational Guide on the day to show us around.



We have visited Feadon Farm in the past with a previous class and it really was a fantastic experience and one of the best trips we have organised. The children are able to see close up the foxes, ferrets, snakes, bats, spiders, hedgehogs, etc., and watch the Harris Hawk flying. One of the highlights of our day out will be the opportunity for the children to actually help fly the Barn & Eagle owls (don't worry – it's all very safe).

We shall travel to Portreath in our school minibuses. The children may wear their own play clothes, with sensible footwear and a waterproof coat/sun hat and sun cream. (We will be outside for most of the day). They will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day. If you would prefer, we can provide a packed lunch from the school canteen.

The cost of this outing will be £10 per child. This will cover our travel expenses, entrance into Feadon Farm and the Educational Guide. **This visit is now set up on our ParentPay system. Please log on to make your £10 contribution, give permission for your child to participate, let us know of any medical conditions and to order a packed lunch if one is required.**

Please could we ask you to complete this transaction on ParentPay by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July, so we can ensure all permissions are in place before our outing.
