Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard:

2019	Penpol	National
Reading	73%	73%
Writing (TA)	76%	78%
Maths	82%	79%
RWM (Reading, writing, maths combined)	65%	65%
GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and spelling)	78%	78%
Science (TA)	86%	83%

The percentage of children achieving the expected standard in year 6 compared with national averages is broadly in line in all areas. Writing is slightly (1 pupil) below whilst maths and science are above.

Percentage of pupils achieving the greater depth standard:

Reading	33%	27%
Writing (TA)	12%	20%
Maths	29%	27%

The percentage of children achieving the greater depth standard in year 6 at national averages is below in writing but above in reading and maths.

The average scaled score is broadly in line with national averages in maths and GPS and slightly above in reading.

Progress measure: (KS1 to KS2)

Writing	-0.86	-0.13
Maths	-0.13	-0.82

Awaiting national confidence intervals for comparison but these are historically close to Cornwall averages. Writing is below expected progress measures but reading and maths is above Cornwall averages.
