CLASS 7 SCHOOL TRIP – TUESDAY 12TH NOVEMBER - GEEVOR TIN MINE AT PENDEEN

We plan to visit Geevor Tin Mine at Pendeen, on Tuesday 12th November as this will put into real life some of the work the children have been studying in class. The education officer from Geevor Mine will also visit Penpol before our trip to lead a workshop with the children, in order that they may get the most out of their visit.
