We are very excited in Classes 7 and 8, as on Tuesday 17th December we will be travelling down to the Solomon Browne Hall in Mousehole to see a magical puppet and live action production of 'The Mousehole Cat'. This term our English lessons have been based on this book and so this is an amazing opportunity for the children to see the story brought to life. This is the fourth consecutive year this show has been performed at this venue and it is usually a complete sell out.



'The Mousehole Cat, tells the tale of how this West Cornwall village was saved from desperate famine by the brave actions of fisherman, Tom Bawcock, and his faithful cat, Mowzer.

Based on a well-known Cornish legend Antonia Barber's uniquely heart-warming story of the friendship between a fearless fisherman and his devoted cat is sure to warm the cockles of your heart almost as much as an 'efty portion of stargazy pie!'

We will travel down to Mousehole by coach, leaving school at 12.45pm. The children will have an early lunch before leaving for the show, so they will still be able to have their usual meal arrangements on this day. We have arranged for the coach to collect us from Mousehole again at 3.30pm, so would therefore expect to be back to Penpol by approximately 4.30pm. The children will need to wear school uniform, bring a coat and if they would like to they may bring a small snack to have after the show.
