

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Exciting news! Based on the high level of interest for the proposed London trip, we have now booked this residential for next year from **Monday 8th to Thursday 11th June 2020**. The trip to London will be a marvellous experience which we hope your child will remember in many years to come. The trip will be organised by us and a company called Curriculum Travel which is part of the Rondo Travel Ltd group.

Accommodation will be at the Wembley International Hotel, Wembley which is in a quieter area of North West London. Children will sleep in air conditioned multi bedded rooms which will be en-suite. The rooms will all be designated in one area with the staff placed either side. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at this base, except for lunch on the first day which will be a packed lunch from home. We will visit restaurants in Central London for our evening meals such as Pizza Express, Garfunkels and the Rainforest Café. This will give us more time for visiting attractions rather than extra time spent travelling on the coach.

An itinerary can't be finalised until Curriculum Travel have a deposit and exact numbers of pupils but this is a flavour of what your child is likely to experience over the week:

- **Executive coach** for journey and throughout the week.
- **The Natural History museum** - dinosaur skeletons!!!!
- **Sightseeing** - Buckingham Palace, the Mall, Horse Guards Parade, Downing St, The Cenotaph, Houses of Parliament, Trafalgar Sq, Leicester Sq, Piccadilly Circus etc
- **West End show**, e.g - Lion King, School of Rock, Matilda or Wicked.
- **London eye** and **4D pre-flight show** - see London from the air!
- **Houses of Parliament** - tour around parliament - meet Local MP.
- **Wembley Stadium** - the UK's largest sporting and music venue.
- **Science Museum + Wonderlab Gallery** - explore and inspire!



The price for all of this will be approximately **£325**. The price is approximate as the itinerary is not yet finalised and we don't know final numbers. As stated before, we will explore avenues and opportunities to see where we can reduce this cost further. Last year, we reduced the price by **£15** per pupil through fundraising and we would hope to repeat or even better this reduction. We are sure those of you that have experienced London know how much it costs to take a family so this is a great price for the amount your child will do and see. This is also a great offer compared to other quotes and Curriculum Travel are well organised and experienced with school parties.

We will be hosting a meeting in **Mr. Peck's classroom** on **Thursday 14th November at 3.20pm** for any parents who would like further information at this stage or would like to talk to us about anything to do with the trip. Children attending might like to go next door into Mr Stanlake's class where we will put a couple of activities out. If you have no questions at this stage you don't necessarily need to attend as there will be further full detailed meetings for both parents and children with more information once itineraries and other things are finalised.

The deadline for paying the **deposit of £50 is 29th November**. **This trip is now set up on our ParentPay system, so please log on to make this initial payment and confirm your child's place.** There will be 52 spaces available and this is one full coach. Please pay your deposit in good time to guarantee your child a place on the trip. If you would like to pay monthly it would work out at **£45 per month from December to April with a final payment of £50 in May** but payments can be flexible to suit yourself of course. You will be able to make payments as and when it suits you via ParentPay. Please speak to us if you feel the cost or payments will be an issue at any point or the cost is a barrier to going on the trip.

A letter will then follow with exact details of the trip but please contact us if you have any questions before making a decision.

We look forward to what promises to be an exciting and rewarding experience for all the children.
