

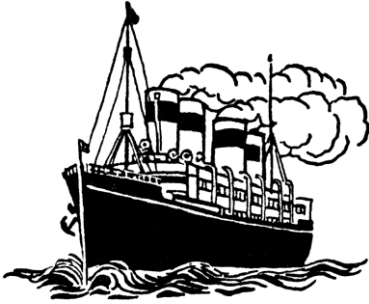

CLASS 1 – VISIT TO THE MARITIME MUSEUM AT FALMOUTH ON TUESDAY 10TH MARCH

As part of our topic of 'All Around the World', Class 1 will be visiting the Maritime Museum in Falmouth.



During this visit, the children will take part in an educational workshop where they will learn about making boats and floating and sinking. We will also meet Oceana, a mischievous Cornish sea sprite, who collects treasures from the seabed and brings them to the museum. The children will learn a magical rhyme to wake her up to come and play. In the afternoon, we will have some time to explore the museum.

Please could the children come to school wearing their home clothes with their Penpol jumper or cardigan, sensible walking shoes and a waterproof coat if it is raining. We will travel to Falmouth in our minibuses, leaving school soon after registration and returning by the usual going home time.

A packed lunch and a drink will be needed. As the children are entitled to free school meals, a packed lunch can be provided from our school canteen. **Please log on to the Aspens Select website to order a packed lunch if required. If you have already made a hot meal selection for this day, please change this to either a packed lunch option or cancel the meal if you will be providing a packed lunch from home.**

The contribution for this trip will be £7.00. This price will cover the cost of entrance and workshop at the Maritime Museum and a contribution towards the travel costs. This visit has been set up on our ParentPay system, so please log on to make the voluntary contribution and to give permission for your child to attend.
