Supporting and preparing your child for Y6 Standard Assessment Tests (SATs)

Dear Parents/Guardians.

Usually we would invite you to an information session in the school hall to discuss the upcoming tests in a little more detail and how best you can support and prepare your child over the next coming months, however under the current circumstances we are unable to.

We will try our best to communicate this information by letter, however if you would like to speak to use regarding the statutory assessments we will happily do so.

Attached is a list of tried and tested useful websites which the children can use to support their home learning. We would usually share with you some test papers however, as we are unable to do so there is a link to where they can be accessed online. Please leave 2019 alone, as we will use this as an assessment tool. The children have already began familiarising themselves with the structure and layout of the questions and tests.

The children also have their CGP Revision/Targeted question books which we have been setting homework in. An excellent opportunity to have some extra support with work in these is our weekly 'Boost Crew' club where we as teachers are on hand to offer tailored individual support.

We are unable to comment on what the next few weeks have instore however, we are in a good position to continue our learning, both in school and remotely. At present SATs week is expected to commence on Monday 11th of May with the timetable for the week on the reverse of this letter.

As teachers, we are very aware that this time of year can be one of stress and heightened anxiety for both yourselves and your children. We have worked closely with the children regarding their wellbeing and have attached a document on how best to support them at home.
