<b>Activity 1</b>  <b>(English)</b>  <b>Play 'Teach your Monster to Read'</b>	<b>Suffixes -ing and -ed</b>  Access Education City Subjects > English > KS1 > Year 1 > Activities  Find the game called 'Roots to Winning' To practise the suffix -ing and -ed  <b>Challenge:</b>  How many words ending with the suffixes -ing and -ed can you spot in a book you are reading?	<b>Capital Letters</b>  Ask an adult to choose a letter of the alphabet for you or pick one from a hat.  How many words can you think of that start with this letter that need a capital letter?  These could be place names, names of people, days of the week, months of the year etc.  <b>Challenge:</b>  Try with different letters!	<b>Listening and Writing</b>  Watch this video ( <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dJD7DM-v6cc">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dJD7DM-v6cc</a> ) of Mr Tumble singing a song. Listen very carefully and see if you can write the words of the song (the <i>lyrics</i> ) down! You might need to pause it a few times. For an extra challenge you could also check your punctuation is correct.  <b>Challenge:</b>  Perform the song, can you remember all the words? You could video it and send it to a friend, relative or to Mrs Sukstiene/Miss Whear!	<b>Fact files!</b>    Create a fact file all about this plant. You might include the name, where they are found, how big they can grow and some interesting facts. Does your poem rhyme? Do all poems have to rhyme? Can you find an example of a poem that doesn't rhyme?  <b>Challenge:</b>  Send your poem to a friend or relative and see if they can guess what plant you are writing about!

### Challenge: Practical

Lacing plates – You'll need paper plates/card and string.

Ask your adult to write the numbers from 0 when skip counting in 2's, 5's, 10's in a random order around the circle. You must then lace the thread through the holes in the correct order.

### Challenge:

Play verbal Ping Pong for doubles and halves.

Adult: "Ping"

Child: "Pong"

Adult: "Ping"

Child: "Pong"

Adult: "Double 2"

Child: "4"

Adult: "Halve 6"

Child: "3"

Write the numbers 0-20 on paper.

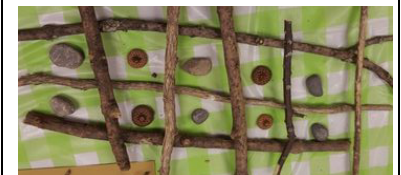
Sort them into odd and even piles.

Pick an even number to halve and either an odd or an even number to double.

You might need more than one tens frame side by side.

Remember when halving you need to start with an even number!

What do you notice when doubling odd/even numbers?
