Dear Parents/Carers,

Reopening in September

You may have seen in the news yesterday that the government have published their guidance for the safe reopening of schools in September. The document recognises that every school is different and we warmly welcome the level of flexibility it allows. It has been three and a half months since we were asked to close to the majority of pupils and we are absolutely delighted to now be able to plan for our full reopening. Unless there are changes to the guidance or any additional local restrictions, we very much look forward to **opening to all current pupils on Monday 7th September**. We will then open to our new Reception pupils the following day, Tuesday 8th September.

Along with our governing body, we are now working meticulously through the guidance to ensure that we open in the **safest possible way** for your child. It is important to note that this may involve some minor changes to school hours and that we may not be ready to open our breakfast and after-school clubs at the very beginning of term. We will, of course, keep you updated here. The government have announced that **attendance** will be considered statutory and we look forward to welcoming every pupil back. Transition

Children moving into Years 1-6 will spend much of their first day back with their current teacher in order to celebrate the year's achievements before moving on to their new classes. We will keep you posted on the details as soon as these are confirmed.

Our **Year 6** pupils **and their parents/carers** are invited to a socially distanced outdoor celebration event on Monday 20th July at 1:30pm. This will be an important opportunity to say a humungous 'well done' to all children in Classes 13 and 14 before they start their next adventure in September. More information will follow next week.

Annual reports for pupils in Years 1 – 6 are almost ready and we would like to invite parents/carers and pupils to collect these from the front of the school in a socially distanced way. Class teachers will be present during the times below to distribute reports and this will also serve as a valuable opportunity to make contact (albeit regrettably briefly) ahead of the holidays. **It is essential that social distancing measures are observed at all times during this process. 
Water Safety
