








At the same time on Mount Cook, New Zealand it is 3:00am. Indiana was sleeping in the wild at the top of Mount Cook in a very special warm tent.


At the same time in Ottawa, Canada

school.



Australian family.






It is 9.20am, Tom has only just woken up and is getting ready for a day of sight-seeing in New York.

in his PJs, whilst watching the news.



At the same moment in the Amazon rainforest, Brazil, it was 9am and Maria was swimming in a waterfall pool.




At the same moment in time it is 15:00 in Italy when the kids excitedly race to the park to play with their friends after a long day at school.




At that same moment in Utah, my




At this time of the day I am lying down on my bed watching online school assembly - it is 1.46 in the afternoon in England, UK.

mum to buy the takeaway.




