Congratulations to all involved in this week's Lego League. Please see below for a special report from Mr Woolcock:

This week was the culmination of months of effort from our Year 5 teams as they took part in the Cornwall Regional Final of the LEGO League Competition. Both teams did exceedingly well with Class 12 coming second and Class 11 coming third overall - out of 12 teams. This included primaries and secondaries from throughout Cornwall.

Class 12's team (LEGO Legends) actually won 'Robot Games' section outright with a massive score of 280 points! Second place went to Class 11 (Robo Legends) with 180 points. Both teams went above and beyond in this area and we are incredibly proud of their teamwork, innovation and perseverance.

Speaking of those values, Class 11 won the award for 'Core Values', demonstrating just how well they worked together as a team and overcame the challenges of the competition. Class 12 won the overall award for their 'Innovation Project' - a phone that only unlocks when you have walked a certain number of steps each day!

A massive well done to both teams, coming second and third in their first ever year of the competition is no mean feat. They have already started planning for next year...
