Safety Update

As you will know, confirmed cases of COVID-19 are increasing rapidly in Cornwall and in our local community. It is essential that, whether vaccinated or not, we all take extra care in adhering to safety measures, both on and off site:

- All parents and guardians are expected to wear a mask whilst on site
 please unless there is a specific reason why this might be detrimental to
 your child.
- Please continue to test twice weekly at home. Test kits are available to
 collect for free from test centres as well as your local pharmacy. They can
 also be ordered online here https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapidlateral-flow-tests.
- Please maintain social distancing on site at all times and ensure that your children stay with you at pick up and drop off. Please avoid using outdoor play equipment as this is carefully cleaned in between each bubbles' use.
- Please continue to follow all government guidance regarding immediate self-isolation and testing in the event of any potential COVID symptoms and inform us at school on secretary@penpol.cornwall.sch.uk
- If your child does test positive for COVID, please notify me as soon as possible on head@penpol.comwall.sch.uk
