



Bodmin Keep- Cornwall's Military Museum

Dear Parents & Carers

In November, the Year 6 classes will be visiting Bodmin Keep, Cornwall's Wartime Museum, to support their curriculum learning about 'Wartime Britain'.

Class 13 will visit on Tuesday 2nd November and Class 14 will visit on Thursday 4th November.

We will be leaving promptly at 9.00 am and travelling by school minibus. We have enrolled on a workshop focusing on trench warfare as well as having access to a guided tour of the keep and its WW2 artefacts; both of which will provide excellent stimuli for writing on our return. There is a slightly different activity planned for the afternoon with a team building activity led by an ex-military Sergeant - which I'm sure will be a lot of fun!

The cost of the trip is £7.50 (£6 for admission and a £1.50 contribution for travel) and this has been set up on ParentPay under payment item 'Year 6 Visit to Bodmin'. Please could all contributions be made by Friday 22nd October. I am pleased to say that included in the £6 admission is a free annual pass allowing the children and their families to return for free.

There is space both inside and outside for the children to eat their packed lunch that they will need to bring with them; school packed lunches can be ordered in advance via Aspdens and collected by staff before we leave at 9.00am.
