Origo Mundi matinee performance

On Monday 13th September, we have managed to get free tickets to take the new Y6 to a matinee performance of Origo Mundi (The Creation) performed by the St Just Ordinalia Company.

The St Just Ordinalia Company is producing all three Medieval Cornish Ordinalia Mystery plays, consisting of The Creation, The Passion and The Resurrection. They are the oldest trilogy of plays in Britain, and they are performing them in the Plen-an-Gwari, St Just, the oldest working theatre in Britain. The company is run by a team of professionals who will be facilitating and supporting a large community cast during rehearsals and performance.

'We want to create an experience that will stay with young people for the rest of their lives, building an excitement around an Ordinalia journey from a young age. We say, journey as our intention is that the Ordinalia will be performed thereafter every 3 years, with members of the community participating to keep these fabulous stories alive for generations.'

This is an outdoor performance so we need to be prepared for all weathers – great sunshine or rain. There is no seating so we ask if each child can bring a blanket or something to sit on but not chairs please. The children will need to bring a packed lunch on the day as we will need to leave before lunchtime and eat our lunch there. If you order a school packed lunch, these will be collected in the morning.

There will be no charge for the performance but we have booked a coach to transport us all there. We would like to ask a voluntary contribution of £4 per child for transport. **Please give permission for your child to attend this performance and make your contribution directly through ParentPay, by this Friday 10th September.**

The performance is from 1pm until 3.30pm approximately so we are anticipating returning to school for 4.30pm.
