

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope that you and your children have been able to enjoy a wonderful summer break. We are very much looking forward to welcoming pupils back next **Tuesday 7th September** for the start of an exciting new school year.

Owing to the relatively high number of COVID-19 cases in the region at present, Cornwall has been designated an <u>Enhanced Response Area</u>. Our local Public Health team has requested that schools take some additional but proportionate steps in order to reduce the spread of coronavirus when we return to school.

At Penpol, the following additional measures will apply when we return next week:

- School staff will be wearing masks in communal areas. They will not be wearing masks when teaching or working directly with children.
- We are asking all <u>parents and guardians</u> to continue wearing a mask whilst on the school site please, unless you are exempt or your child has particular needs which may be adversely impacted.
- We will continue to use one-way systems for drop-off and collection for the time being. If your child is starting school this term, please enter by the main pedestrian gate. Drop off times are now between 8:45am and 9:00am. Pick-up times are from 3:00pm to 3:15pm.
- We will be reducing the mixing of children from different year groups throughout the day where reasonably practicable.

Each of these measures will be reviewed regularly, with renewed advice expected from the Public Health team in two weeks' time.

We should all continue to help in the following ways:

- All adults are asked to please test regularly with lateral flow tests, available here: https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests
- We encourage all adults to become fully vaccinated where they are not already.
- If any member of your household shows potential symptoms of COVID-19, they must isolate immediately and arrange a PCR test. More information is available here: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/
- Please continue to engage with and follow the advice of the NHS track and Trace team.

Thank you all for your support here. It is important to remember that, although these proportionate measures will be with us in the short term, we are beginning a school year with far fewer restrictions than we have been used to for some time. This presents a great deal more room for **creativity**, **fun** and **adventure** and we look forward to a truly exciting year ahead.
