



Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will know, our pupils all enjoy our 360 Degree Curriculum over the year. This offers them the opportunity to enjoy learning beyond the classroom through **Experience, Citizenship, Adventure** and **Forest School** provision. The Adventure theme includes **camp**s and **overnight stays**, where children can create life-long memories. These begin in Year 2 and build over the following years to the final London visit in Year 6.

The aim of these visits is to build the children's confidence and independence by trying new activities with friends and having fun in new environments. The places we have chosen all offer different levels of adventure and have a well-established reputation for offering school camps or visits.

Below is the plan for each year group and a current approximate cost of the trip activities and accommodation. A more detailed letter will follow about each individual trip. All of these trips will be set up on Parent Pay in the next week so that you can pay in instalments if you wish. You will be able to pay as and when works for you, until the balance is paid in full.

The cost below (**except the trip to London**) does not include the travel expenses, so over the year each class will be fundraising to raise the extra money towards any travel or extra costs. We hope the children will enjoy planning a variety of activities and that this will mean any additional final travel costs will be minimal.

We wanted to share this with you as early as possible but do understand that these contributions may be difficult. In planning these trips, we are determined that cost must not be a barrier to attendance for any child.
