## The Governing Body



2023/2024

* To ensure the business of the Governing Body is conducted properly, in accordance with legal and Council delegation requirements.
* To ensure meetings are run effectively, focusing on priorities and making the best use of time available, and to ensure that all members have an equal opportunity to participate in discussion and decision-making
* To establish and foster an effective relationship with the Headteacher based on trust and mutual respect for each other's roles. The Chair has an important role in ensuring that the Governing Body acts as a sounding board to the Headteacher and provides strategic direction

## The Role of the Clerk to the Governing Body

* To work effectively with the Chair of Governors, the other Governors and the Headteacher to support the Governing Body
* To advise the Governing Body on Constitutional and Procedural Matters, duties and powers
* To convene meetings of the Governing Body
* To attend meetings of the Governing Body and ensure minutes are taken
* To maintain a register of members of the Governing Body and report vacancies to the Governing Body
* To give and receive notices in accordance with relevant regulations
* To perform such other functions as may be determined by the Governing Body from time to time

## The Role of the Chair of a Committee

* To ensure the business of the Committee is conducted properly, in accordance with legal requirements
* To ensure meetings are run effectively, focusing on priorities and making the best use of time available, and to ensure that all members have an equal opportunity to participate in discussion and decision-making


## Disqualification - none

The Role of the Clerk to Committees

* To advise the Committee on procedural and legal matters
* To convene meetings of the Committee
* To attend meetings of the Committee and ensure minutes are taken
* To perform such other functions with respect to the Committee as may be determined by the Governing Body from time to time

The Governing Body needs to take a strategic role, act as a critical friend to the School and be accountable for its decisions. It should set aims and objectives and agree, monitor and review policies, targets and priorities

## Terms of reference:

- To agree constitutional matters*, including procedures where the Governing Body has discretion
- To recruit new members as vacancies arise and to appoint new governors* where appropriate
- To hold at least three Governing Body meetings a year*
- To appoint or remove the Chair and Vice Chair*
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to the Governing Body*
- To establish the committees of the Governing Body and their terms of reference*
- To appoint the Chair of any committee (if not delegated to the committee itself)
- To appoint or remove a Clerk to each committee*
- To suspend a governor*
- To decide which functions of the Governing Body will be delegated to committees, groups and individuals*
- To receive reports from any individual or committee to whom a decision has been delegated and to consider whether any further action by the Governing Body is necessary*
- To approve the first formal budget plan of the financial year
- To keep the Health and Safety Policy and its practice under review and to make revisions where appropriate
- To review the delegation arrangements annually*
- To ensure that the guidance contained in the 'Improving Attendance and Behaviour' document is practised in the school, with specific reference to the role assigned to the Governing Body.
- To review the School Behaviour and Discipline Policy, and make recommendations on changes to the Governing Body or relevant committee
- To consider and advise the governing body on standards and other matters relating to the school's curriculum, including statutory requirements and the School's Curriculum Policy
- To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance and Personnel decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or the Governing Body
- To make arrangements for the Governing Body to be represented at School Improvement discussions with the LA and for reports to be received by the Governing Body
- To oversee arrangements for individual governors to take a leading role in specific areas of provision, eg SEN, Literacy, Numeracy. To receive regular reports from them and advise the Governing Body.
- To draft and keep under review the staffing structure in consultation with the Headteacher
- To oversee the process leading to staff reductions
- To oversee the appointment procedure for all staff
*these matters cannot be delegated to either a committee or an individual

First Committee (Staff / Pupil Discipline / Complaints)

## Terms of reference:

- To make any determination to dismiss any member of staff (unless delegated to the headteacher)
- To make any decisions under the Governing Body's personnel procedures e.g. disciplinary, grievance, capability where the Headteacher is the subject of the action*
- To make any determination or decision under the Governing Body's General Complaints Procedure for Parents and others
- To make any determination or decision under the Governing Body's Curriculum Complaints Procedure, in respect of National Curriculum disapplication's, and the operation of the Governing Body's charging policy:
- To consider representations from parents in the case of exclusions of 5 days or less (Committee may not re-instate)
- To consider representations from parents in the case of exclusions totalling more than 5 but not more than 15 school days in one term (meeting to be held between $6^{\text {th }}$ and $50^{\text {th }}$ school days after receiving notice of the exclusion)
- To consider the appropriateness of any permanent exclusion or any exclusion where one or more fixed period exclusions total more than 15 school days in one term or where a pupil is denied the chance to take a public examination (meeting to be held between $6^{\text {th }}$ and $15^{\text {th }}$ school days after receiving notice of the exclusion)
*cannot be delegated to an individual


## Membership-3 or 5

NB. The Governing Body may nominate a pool of governors from which three or five will serve as the Discipline Committee to consider particular exclusions. If a governor has a connection with the pupil or the incident that could affect their ability to act impartially they should not serve at the hearing. If, through non-attendance of a governor, four members consider an exclusion, the chair has the casting vote.

## Disqualification - The Headteacher

Any Governor with prior knowledge of the pupil or the incident.
(It is suggested that neither the Chairman of Governors nor a member of staff, due to probable prior knowledge, should be a member)
