



Storm Eunice Update Thursday 17th February 2022

Dear All,

As you may have seen, there is now a red weather warning for wind in place tomorrow morning. <https://www.metoffice.gov.uk/weather/warnings-and-advice/uk-warnings#?id=f3167677-9b5e-464a-b11b-a9d00f9d392b&date=2022-02-18>.

The advice from the Met Office is to stay inside where possible due to a likely risk of flying debris, fallen trees and power lines.

Given this, we have sadly assessed that we must **close the school for tomorrow, Friday 18th February**, to avoid putting our pupils, families and staff members at risk. I have discussed this decision carefully with the local authority and with our Chair of Governors, Nikki Powell.

We wanted to let you know as soon as possible so that you are able to make childcare arrangements. There are no changes to our school day for today (Thursday).
