



Dear Parents/Carers,

On Tuesday the 7<sup>th</sup> of June (Class 11) and Thursday the 9<sup>th</sup> of June (Class 12), the children will be taking part in a workshop with the world-renowned Leach Pottery in St Ives. We will travel by minibus, spending half of the day there and the other half of the day at The Tate Gallery/Barbara Hepworth Museum in St Ives.

Whilst at Leach Pottery, the children will take a tour of the building, learning about the history of the business and the importance of it within the art-world and within St Ives, whilst also getting the opportunity to practice their sketching skills. Also, they will be given the opportunity to create and design their own cup, which they will get to keep once it has been fired.

This trip links in well with our focus on sustainability this term, as well as highlighting an important industry within Cornwall – Leach Pottery being one of the highest regarded and well-known studio potteries in the world.

The cost of this trip will be £4 to cover the cost of the minibus and also the materials and firing for their mugs. This has been set up on ParentPay, so we would be most grateful if you could log on to make this contribution. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water to drink for the day. You may like to provide a packed lunch from home or you are able to order one from the Aspens site by choosing the 'Packed Lunch' option.
