


Penpol School

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Tuesday the 24th of May (Class 11) and Thursday the 26th of May (Class 12), the children will be taking part in a conservation workshop at Trefewha Farm, near Praze. We will travel by minibus, spending the majority of the day there.

Whilst at Trefewha Farm, the children will take a tour of the farm, learning about the history of the business and the importance of it and its focus on permaculture, sustainability and conservation, whilst also getting the opportunity to help to develop a part of the farm for future use. Also, the hope is that in the future each year group will spend time at the farm, with the ability to see the changes and growth which they will have helped to make.

This trip links in well with our focus on sustainability this term, as well as highlighting an important industry within Cornwall – permaculture and farming sustainably being two key focusses.

The cost of this trip will be £1 to cover the cost of the minibus. This has been set up on ParentPay, so we would be most grateful if you could log on to make this contribution. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water to drink for the day. You may like to provide a packed lunch from home or you are able to order one from the Aspens site by choosing the 'Packed Lunch' option. If you have already pre-ordered a hot meal for this day, please ensure that you log on and change this.

The children will need to wear their own clothes which may get dirty, a waterproof jacket, work-gloves and waterproof boots, e.g. wellingtons or hiking boots. This is all very similar to what they wear to forest school with the extra of also requiring gloves.

I hope you agree that this will be an exciting day for the children, after missing out on so much in the last few years.
