CLASS 1 – A DAY AT THE BEACH ON FRIDAY 15[™] JULY

On Friday 15th July, Class 1 are planning to spend a day at the beach.

We will travel in our school minibuses to Hayle beach. The children will need to wear clothes suitable for the beach. Please could the boys come to school wearing their swimming trunks under their clothes and make sure they bring a spare pair of pants in their bag. Please could the girls come wearing their swimming costumes, rolled down, under their clothes in case they need the toilet before we head off for the day. Again, please could you make sure you send a pair of pants in



their bags for changing into after. If they have them, it would be really helpful if the children could bring a changing robe with them or a small towel.

It is very important that the children have sun cream applied in the morning and wear a sun hat. Please can you also send the children with sun cream for a top-up during the day.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of water to drink for the day. If you would prefer, you can order a packed lunch from our school canteen by choosing this option on Aspens.

We are grateful to Ben Holtaway from the Surf Life Saving Club, who will talk to the children about beach safety and organise some surf lifesaving beach games. The children will also get a chance to have a go at surfing. The beach lifeguards will be in attendance.

As the children will be going in the water this visit will not be covered by the trip consent form we hold. Please would you therefore sign and return the slip below, giving permission for your child to attend. **Please could all slips be returned by Wednesday 13th July**.
