The roads are expected to be exceptionally icy tomorrow morning which may cause problems for some of our staff and pupils on their journey to work. Given this, we will operate a **relaxed start to the day tomorrow** (Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December) for pupils.

- If children **need** to be in school at the start of the day and can get to us safely, they are welcome to join us at 8:45am. They may be looked after in a different room from normal at this time.
- We will aim to open our **breakfast club** to those booked in who need it. However, we cannot guarantee normal staffing levels here and, if alternative arrangements are available to you, we would be very grateful.
- Children will not be expected to arrive at school until **10:30am**, at which point we aim for normal lessons to resume.
- When your child arrives at school, **please walk them to their classroom door** and ensure that an adult has received them into the classroom. This will allow us to complete our registers safely.
  
- We will aim for our **Key Stage 1 Concert** to start later than scheduled, shortly after 10:30am. Children in **Years 1 and 2 (Classes 3-6) are invited to meet us at the church between 10:20am and 10:30am**. Any children arriving at school before 10am will walk down with our team.
- **Please do not bring children in Years 1 and 2 to school after 10am as our team will have left for the church.**

Most importantly, please do take care and avoid any rushing on your journey. We will keep you posted with any further changes via text and email.
