

Dear Parents and Guardians.

As you may know, teachers do not get paid when they strike. Sadly, the dispute continues and we sincerely hope for a positive resolution soon. Needless to say, partially closing the school is never something we would want to do and we are enormously grateful for your flexibility and understanding here.

Given the partial closure, we have rescheduled this for the new date of Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. **Aspens** Looking ahead to September, there are a number necessary updates to the way our onsite food provision with **Aspens** works:

- We are proud of our lunch provision and have signed up to a service which will independently quality-assure our school meals to ensure that high standards and best value are maintained for all.
- In light of the increase in costs experienced by all sectors, the cost of our school lunches will need to rise to £2.53 per meal. We have worked hard to avoid increasing costs for some time but need to ensure that school meals are not unfairly subsidised by the broader school budget. Thank you for your understanding here. - Finally, from September, if your child is away from school due to sickness, we are asking
  parents and carers to cancel your pre-booked meals for each day. This will avoid you
  being charged and allow our busy office team to balance their workload more
