- A lot of focus on KS2 due to the level of understanding but feel we need to assess EYFS/KS1 to check resources and think of gaps they may benefit from workshops on or resources.

How to improve further?

- Making all children feel included at break time- lunchtime support for KS2 in similar way Playground Buddies is utilised in younger years playground.
- On the topic of notice boards, it was raised that there is a plan for one notice board to be used as a tactile experience for children and will be updated to include touch input- a welcome sensory experience to the corridor.

TARGETS:

- Expand on disability/hidden disability discussion. This would be through assemblies, books, and the ongoing Tigger Pritchards advice and support.
- Look into the idea of a task force team badge.
- Further work around celebrating religious and linguistic diversity.
- Makaton sign of the week reminders to continue and be expanded.
 Open discussion about words we learn, maybe how they are said, sign, drawn in a multimodal approach.
