Forest School

Starting after Easter, Years 5 and 6 will be starting forest school again.

These sessions will be run by Mrs Allen and they will be held at our onsite Forest School.

These will include shelter building, knot tying, making fires, outdoor cooking, arts and crafts, team games and much more!
