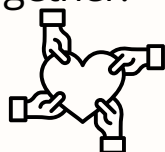
Forward Together Sessions

Forward Together Sessions place families at the heart of school life, helping us to work in close partnership to support every child. We will be sharing our Forward Together Sessions dates with you soon.

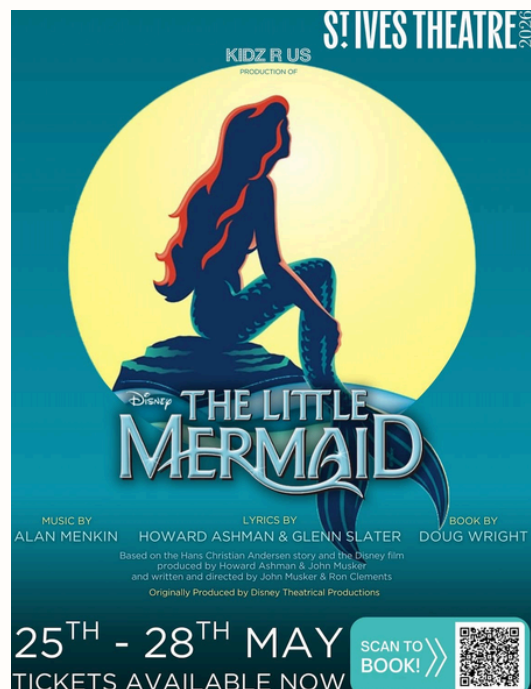
